### **Rules and Policies for Educational Classes and Clubs Sponsored by Anthony T. Lane Elementary School PTA**

- Enrollment will be contingent upon receipt of payment in full and receipt of an enrollment form with consent to participate signed by a parent or guardian. The Lane PTA assumes NO responsibility for missing cash payments. An \$8 fee will be charged for returned checks.
- Students should be picked up promptly at the assigned ending time. Continued failure to do so may result in from the program WITHOUT a refund.  
(Lane ES and the Lane PTA do NOT have staff to stay after with your child.)
- Students must be picked up by an adult listed as having permission to pick up the child. Representatives of the Lane PTA will NOT dismiss children to unauthorized persons.
- Representatives of the Lane PTA will make every effort to locate a student if he/she does not show up for class, but ultimately the parent or guardian is responsible for making sure the student gets where he/she needs to be.
