

CHC 2P – Canadian History Since World War I

Course Outline

Canadian history is the story of our past – the people of Canada, your grandparents, your ancestors.

It is also the story of our present – how and why we live the way we do today.

We study Canadian history to gain a better understanding and appreciation of our past and present.

History class is no longer about memorizing random names, facts, and dates. In this course we focus on investigation, interpretation, and critical thinking.

The course is divided into 4 units and a final summative assignment. There are no tests or exams. Your course mark will be based on the assignments you complete for each unit.
